To celebrate the natural environment within the City of Greater Sudbury, The Northern Artist Gallery is hosting the fifth annual "Picture our Lakes" photography contest. Residents and visitors are encouraged to submit their most beautiful Sudbury photos in five categories: spring, summer, fall, winter and Youth (under 18). This year's 'Picture our Lakes' contest will include photos of lakes, wetlands, and watersheds (creeks and ponds), as well as the landscapes, wildlife and seasonal flora that are found in and around Sudbury's water bodies. All photos must include some element of water. The final date for submissions is Friday, June 10, 2011. (Please read contest rules) The pictures that best represent the contest theme and the four seasons will be displayed at Artists on Elgin during July 2011. Visitors to the Gallery will vote for winning photos to be featured in a 2012 calendar. The overall winner chosen by a blue ribbon panel of judges will be featured on the cover.

### Contest rules:

1. Photographs submitted must be the property of the entrant and must not have been previously published or under consideration for publication.
2. All pictures submitted must be in **both**, print and digital formats:
  - a. **Print requirements:**  
4 inches x 6 inches horizontal, in colour or black and white. Photo paper, or 100lb gloss cover (consult your local copy shop for more information.) These photos must be unmounted, with **NO** date, time stamp or signature on the front of the photograph.
  - b. **Digital recommendations:**  
8 inches x 12 inches horizontal / landscape, minimum 300 dpi (dots per inch) or your digital camera setting may read these requirements as 3600 pixels X 2400 pixels. Maximum quality. This must be provided as a .jpg or a .tiff file  
All Digital files should be labeled: (LASTNAME\_ FIRSTNAME\_ TITLE OF PICTURE) CD's should be labeled with a marker.
3. Every photograph submitted must have a label attached to the back of the picture, (**do not write directly on the photograph**) with the following information:
  - a. Entrant's name
  - b. Entrant's address, telephone number and email address
  - c. Site Location of the photograph
  - d. Date of photograph
  - e. Submission Category: Summer, Fall, Winter, Spring, Youth (include age)
4. Entrants must include the following contest fee:-One picture \$2.00 -Two pictures \$4.00 -Three or Four pictures \$5.00
5. The photographer retains rights to the photographic image. Photographs may be used in The Northern Artist Gallery/Artists on Elgin publications and/or website and in the Picture our Lakes 2012 Calendar and shared with other community stakeholders for non commercial purposes. Any photographs displayed will appear with a credit to the photographer.
6. Photographs entered in the contest will not be returned, and become the property of the Northern Artist Gallery / Artists on Elgin and its supporters.
7. Entrants in the youth category must be 18 years or younger on Dec. 31st 2011.
8. LAKES MUST BE WITHIN THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY'S BOUNDARIES.
